### 1. Application Form

- It is strongly recommended that your application be critically reviewed by a professor or student advisor(s) prior to submission.

### 2. Two Letters of Reference

- The referees must be able to provide a professional assessment of your academic, personal skills and research potential.
- One letter must be from one of your professors
- Both letters must be on the organization's official letterhead
- Both letters must be emailed to [jennmitchell.tfio@bellnet.ca](mailto:jennmitchell.tfio@bellnet.ca) and must be sent directly from the referee's email address

### 3. Transcripts

- Official transcripts are required from your current college/university.
- They must include the most recent semester completed at your current college/university.
- Transcripts should be scanned and emailed to [jennmitchell.tfio@bellnet.ca](mailto:jennmitchell.tfio@bellnet.ca)
