1. Application Form

- It is strongly recommended that your application be critically reviewed by a professor or student advisor(s) prior to submission.

2. Two Letters of Reference

- The referees must be able to provide a professional assessment of your academic, personal skills and research potential.
- One letter must be from one of your professors
- Both letters must be on the organization's official letterhead
- Both letters must be emailed to jennmitchell.tfio@bellnet.ca and must be sent directly from the referee's email address

3. Transcripts

- Official transcripts are required from your current college/university.
- They must include the most recent semester completed at your current college/university.
- Transcripts should be scanned and emailed to jennmitchell.tfio@bellnet.ca
- If COVID restrictions limit you from getting this information, contact Laura Shantz to discuss: jennmitchell.tfio@bellnet.ca

4. The Deadline to receive your application is May 17, 2024

- Please include all of the required documents (other than reference letters) in one email.
